

## **Spectator Information**

Dear Coaches, Parents and Spectators:

We look forward to welcoming you to the 20th Annual New Jersey Scholastic Rowing Championship on Saturday, May 22, 2010. Please take a moment to read the following information. There will be no curbside parking on either side of North Park Drive. Cars parked in these areas will be ticketed.

### **CARS:**

- Parking: All spectators are asked to access the course using Donahue Ave. Donahue Avenue is located 200 yards on the right just past the Howard Johnson's on Rt 70 East. Paid parking will be available at the Living Faith Christian Academy which is on the corner of North Park Drive and Donahue Avenue (across from the finish line).
- Parking is \$10 per car. There are NO IN/OUT Privileges.
- From NJ Turnpike or RT. 295 follow Rt. 70 West. You will pass the Crown Plaza on your left. Proceed past the cemetery and get in your right hand lane. Follow the jug handle immediately after Goodwill and cross over Rt. 70 make a left hand turn and head East on Rt 70. Pass the Howard Johnsons and make your first right onto Donahue Avenue. Follow Donahue Avenue straight until you see the park directly in front of you.
- From the Ben Franklin Bridge. Follow Rt. 30 East (Admiral Wilson Blvd) to Rt. 70 East. Stay in your right lane. Pass the Howard Johnsons and make your first right onto Donahue Avenue.

### **FOOD TRAILERS:**

- For closer access, food trailers parked in the Williamson lot, which is located on North Park Drive just west of the Pavilion. Food trailers must be unhitched from their tow vehicle. Parking will not available until Saturday morning at 5a.m.
- Schools and parent groups are not allowed to drive their trailers on the grass to designated tent area. All tents, equipment and grills must be carried in from curbside (suggest bringing a cart or wagon) you are allowed to set up your tents anytime after 3:00 PM on Friday but we do not provide security. No tent shall be within 100 feet of the finish line.
- All tents must be 50 feet from the banks of
- the river. If you have two tents you must place the second tent 75 feet behind the first to adequate space for emergency vehicles to access the area.
- No vehicles are permitted next to your tent. You will be towed.

- You are allowed to cook for your teams, but you can't sell food or drink to the public. Please use the utmost care when using a grill. Properly dispose of coals and waste after you are finished.
- Please trash. If you need extra garbage bags come to the finish line and we will provide them for you.

### **BOAT TRAILERS & TEAM TRUCKS:**

- Please park your boat trailers in the staging area on the corner of North Park Drive and Cuthbert Road.
- Security will be provided Friday evening through Saturday morning.
- Team trucks/tow vehicle can park on North Park Drive between the team staging area and Donahue Avenue (behind the finish line). You need a regatta parking permit.
